UPGRADES AND SPECIAL DETAILS



MAIN LIVING LEVEL

- Replaced the original glass doors from the living room to the back deck with the current attractive divided light doors
- Replaced the original cherry-color kitchen cabinets with higher-quality cabinets with shaker-style door panels and painted the cabinets in a warm, light grey, installed modern handles
- Replaced the kitchen faucet with a touch faucet

- Replaced the garbage disposal with a high-quality, long-life disposal
- Installed an efficient hood connected to the chimney over the oven (original exhaust combined with the microwave oven and inefficient)
- Added under-cabinet lighting in the kitchen

TOP FLOOR

- Built out the walk-in closet in the master bedroom
- Replaced original toilets with the current modern all-in-one versions in all bathrooms.
- Replaced the bathroom cabinet and sink with a modern vanity and sink in the master bathroom.
- Added shelving in the washer-dryer closet

LOWER LEVEL

- Replaced the bathroom cabinet and sink with a modern vanity and sink in the lower-level guest bathroom.
- Our interior designer created the TV/media area in the lower level
- with a large TV and an ethanol fireplace.
- Added under-cabinet lighting in the bar area in the recreation room

GENERAL

- Rebuilt the front staircase from the sidewalk to the front door
- Replaced most of the original folding doors and door hardware to storage places and closets (basement bedroom, closet next to back door, closet in master
- bedroom), and replaced knobs on all folding doors.
- Replaced all original door knobs with modern door knobs.
- Replaced original carpet-covered stairs down to the basement with

- current wood stairs matching the living room wood floor.
- Replaced the original low-quality carpet in the basement with the current high-quality carpet and plush carpet pad.
- Installed all new window treatments throughout the home
- Recently painted all the walls in the entire house
- Added shelving in the basement storage closet
- Replaced the original fence with the new solid cedar fence on the east side of the house in conjunction with the builder of the new house next door
- Replaced the two old gates on the eastern side of the house and the garage with more sturdy and good looking gates

- Painted the iron fence and rails at the front of the house
- Painted a majority of the home exterior
- Added detectors and alarm system in the entire home (ADT)
- Added shelving and bike racks in the garage, and added additional storage on a platform under the roof of the garage
- Added a 220V outlet in the garage for fast charging of electric cars.
- Added a battery backup to the sump pump in the utility closet
- Replaced all fire alarm detectors.
- Replaced all recessed lighting with current modern lighting
